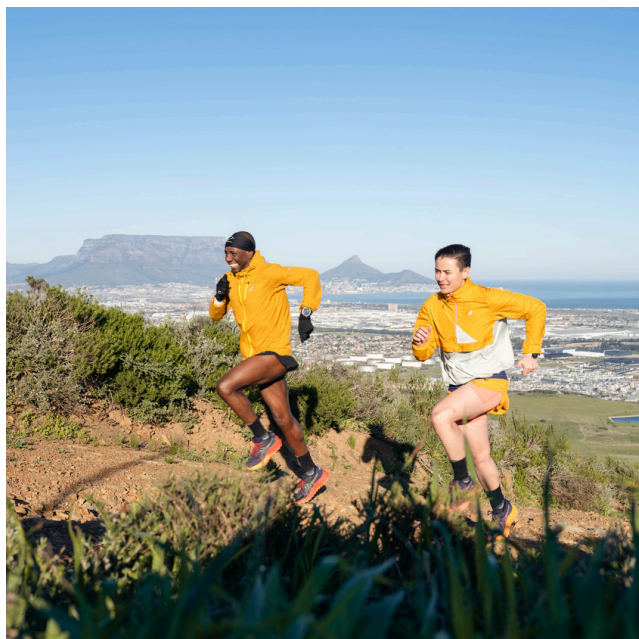
Short Route - 5km

Parking:

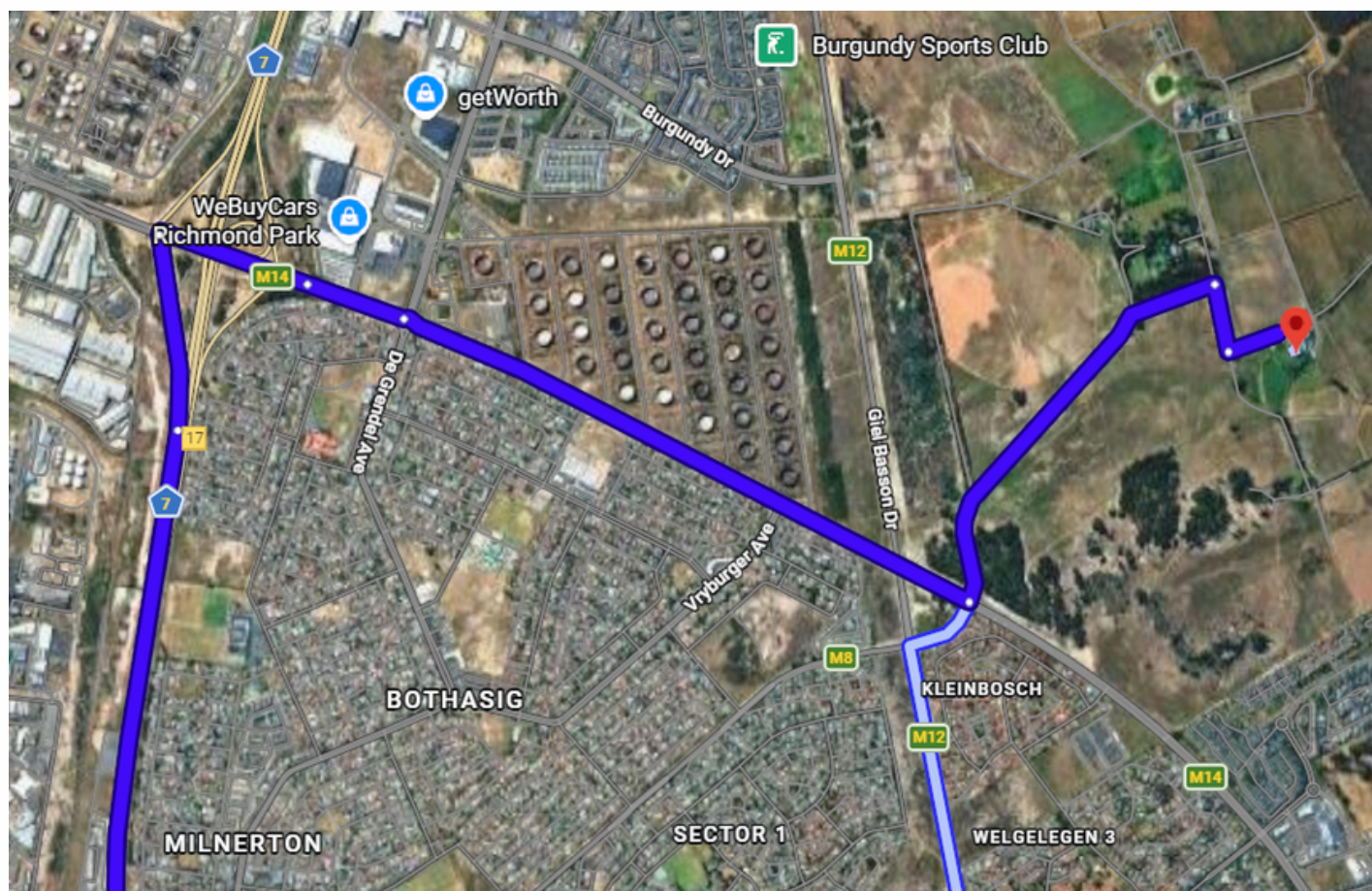
Parking is on the grass section next to the dam and not by the restaurant. Please follow the instructions of the parking marshals.
